Dr. Philip Feifan Xie is Dean and Professor of Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality Management at Macau University of Science and Technology. Previously he was Chair of Sport Management, Recreation and Tourism Division and School Director of Human Movement, Sport and Leisure Studies at Bowling Green State University, Ohio, USA. Dr. Xie received his Ph.D. in planning from University of Waterloo, Canada in 2001.

Prior to joining Bowling Green State University, he was Lecturer in the Department of Geography at University of Toronto in 2000. He was tenured full Professor at Bowling Green State University as well as Visiting Professor at Hong Kong Polytechnic University teaching tourism and hospitality courses.

Professor Xie undertakes research, writes and consults in the field of cultural heritage tourism, aboriginal tourism, event planning and the morphology of tourism. He received several major grants from State and Federal governments in both USA and Macau. Professor Xie has authored two books: Industrial Heritage Tourism (2015) and Authenticating Ethnic Tourism (2010). In addition, he has participated in writing 14 book chapters and more than 50 manuscripts published in international journals.
